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

It is important to understand that the existence of this Document alone does not automatically constitute authority to instal part/component/assembly.

Where the user/installer work in accordance with the national regulations of an Airworthiness Authority different than the Airworth Authority of the country specified in block 1 it is essential that the user/installer ensures that his/her Airworthiness Authority ac parts/components/assemblies from the Airworthiness Authority of the country specified in block 1.

Statements in block 14 and 19 do not constitute installation certification. In all cases aircraft maintenance records must contain installation certification issued in accordance with the national regulations by the user/installer before the aircraft may be flown.
